Subject: Transition of Air Ducts (ALLUC) to Air Ducts Certified for Canada (ALLU7)

UL is striving to offer to its customers a single Canadian Certification Program. In doing so, UL is merging the activities of UL LLC and Underwriters Laboratories of Canada Inc. (ULC) in order to provide a seamless and single face of UL to the users. There are certain administrative activities that are taking place; one such activity is combining all certifications for a given Canadian Category (CCN) where one exists into a single directory location.

Consequently, UL is merging the existing certification category Air Ducts (ALLUC) into the existing certification category Air Ducts Certified for Canada (ALLU7). As the category ALLUC is being transitioned, the products that are currently certified under ALLUC will be transferred to ALLU7.

This consolidation and the movement of all Listings pose no impact to you. The certification category uses the same requirements as in the category ALLUC. The consolidation of CCNs permits the continued use of the existing ULC certification mark. However, a benefit of this consolidation alternatively permits the use of the cUL certification mark, or UL's new enhanced certification mark.

This consolidation is primarily administrative and will occur within the UL & ULC Certification Directories. Any necessary revisions to your File will be notified and will be at no charge to you. We anticipate completing this transition by July 31, 2015.
