## **CERTIFICATION BULLETIN 2017-01**

## First Edition – CAN/ULC-S669-14 – Standard for Internal Retrofit Systems for Underground Tanks for Flammable & Combustible Liquids; Recertification of UST Internal Retrofit Systems and Materials for Compliance

This Bulletin is in continuation to ULC Standards Bulletin 2014-24 issued on September 30, 2014 and to notify manufacturers of UST Retrofit Systems Listed under EGSJC and component material suppliers Recognized under EGVV8 of plans to implement the new ULC-S669 requirements published Oct, 2014, which has replaced the old ULC-ORD C58.4 requirements.

Our original plan to handle recertification of affected systems and materials (products) to ULC-S669, was to add them to the ongoing UL1856 Industry File Review (IFR) for compliance by the same Jun 14, 2017 effective date, since the requirements are almost identical, and would have benefited those with UL & ULC Dual Certifications.

However, we have now determined that recertification of products to S669 and UL1856 should be separately handled with different effective dates, due to the following:

- A manufacturer request to extend the effective date in Canada,
- Allowing material suppliers time to combine testing with other recent ULC Standards, and
- Allowing ULC Standards time to correct errors found in S669.

Therefore, we are keeping the UL1856 IFR on schedule for compliance by the Jun 14, 2017 effective date, but are initiating a new S669 IFR for compliance by the Oct 1, 2018 effective date.

Also, please note that products in compliance on or before an effective date will be moved from the old EGSJC to the new EGAF7 category, and products not in compliance by the effective date will be withdrawn, along with the old CCN.

Note although there are now separate IFR schedules and effective dates for UL1856 & S669 compliance, any manufacturer may request a harmonized testing program for their products to meet both Standards under a Dual Certification.
